The serious Racing will start on;

- Friday 20st October 2023 with the New Zealand Trailer Yacht Association National Championships and the Ross 780 South Island Championships. There may be other Class champs added to this list on a later date.

- -But on the Saturday we have the Swanny Fun race this will entertain the less competitive sailors
- -Sunday 22nd October is the main event the Trust Aoraki Aviemore Classic which is a 2 lap course around the Lake.
- -This year we are promoting the "Fun Division" Aviemore Classic half race One lap course of the lake.

This would be one of the safest trailer yacht regattas in the country as we are extremely well supported by Coast Guard (and others) to ensure that the whole lake is patrolled when the yachts are racing. Great for the new and novice sailors to know they are being supported if needed.
