NB: The notation [DP] in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification and the notation [NP] in a rule in the Notice of Race means rules that are not grounds for protest by a boat.

1.0 Rules

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Current Racing Rules of Sailing. (RRS)
- 1.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations Part V – Trailer Yachts and Sports Trailer Yachts, Category C and Part VI – Sports Boats, Category A shall apply

2.0 Changes to Class Rules [DP] [NP] Any boat or sail plan modification from the class rules must be declared on entry and no later than 0930 hours on Saturday. The Organising Authority reserves the right to alter boat handicaps.

3.0 Eligibility and Entry – NOTE All boats must enter the Trust Aoraki Aviemore Classic

3.1 **SATURDAY: AVIEMORE TRAILER and SPORT BOAT YACHT CHAMPS**

Open to all Trailer Yachts and Sports Boats as appropriate of Divisions as below.

HUTTONS HONEY----- A Division – Rating 0.860 and above
REDPATHS ----- B Division – Rating 0.766 to 0.859
BURNSCO ----- C Division – Rating 0.765 to 0.745
AIR SAFARIS ----- S Division – Sports Boats

Note-These Divisions are **NOT** the same as for the Aviemore Classic Race on Sunday

3.2 **SUNDAY: - The TRUST AORAKI - AVIEMORE CLASSIC**

Open to all Trailer Yachts and Sports Boats of divisions as below.

OBORN'S NAUTICAL. ----- A Division – Rating 0.805 and below
INTERISLANDER----- B Division – Rating 0.806 to 844
WALLACE & COOPER ----- C Division – Rating 0.845 (Noelx 25)
MARINE & AUTO ----- D Division – Rating 0.846 and above
INFLITE MOUNT COOK ----- R Division – No Spinnakers to be used, all ratings
BURNSCO ----- F Division – Fun Division (Short Course)
MR BOATS TIMARU ----- S Division – Sports Boats

3.3 Entries shall be made on, the official entry form, and received by the Race Secretary

By the Saturday before race weekend.

- 3.4 Late entries, accompanied by an additional late entry fee of \$25 may be accepted at the Race Committee's discretion until the end of registrations on the Saturday of the race weekend.
- 3.5 Measurement requirements are that **safety checks may be made on all boats, including centreboard locks**
- 3.6 To be eligible to compete each Owner and Skipper shall be a member of a club or organisation affiliated to YNZ.

4.0 Schedule of Events

- 4.1 **Safety Checks** Saturday, 0800—until end of registrations. Otematata Boat Harbour.
- 4.2 **Registration:** Under COVID Level 1 The owner or representative shall **sign in** prior to the racing at Race Control at the Otematata Boat Harbour - **Under COVID Level 2 sign in will be digital, procedure available in Sailing Instructions**
- 4.3 **Briefing:** Saturday, 1030 hours Otematata Boat Harbour
Sunday, 0815 hours Otematata Boat Harbour
Under COVID Level 2 briefing will be online, see Sailing Instructions for details
- 4.4 **Racing Schedule:** The scheduled time of the first warning signal for the **CHAMPS Series** Race 1 is 1155 hours on Saturday. Four back to back races are scheduled on the Saturday. No race on the Saturday shall start after 1630 hours. The Champs Series will consist of the races held on Saturday only.
The scheduled time of the first warning signal for **The TYPBC Aviemore Classic** is 0955 hours on Sunday

5.0 Sailing Instructions The Sailing Instructions will be available on the TYPBC Website one week prior to the event and at completion of registration.

6.0 Racing Area The races will be held on Lake Aviemore. The start area will be in the vicinity between Parsons Rock and Te Aka.

7.0 Courses to be Sailed

7.1 Saturday courses will be windward-leeward. A separating mark will be laid at mark 1 as shown in Appendix "A".

7.2 Sunday course will be the Trust Aoraki Aviemore Classic course is shown in Appendix "B"

Note: There is now an alternative heavy weather course for the Trust Aoraki Aviemore Classic – this course will only be used during significantly adverse Westerly weather conditions.

8.0 Scoring

8.1 Current NZTYA Ratings will be applied to finishing times for the Saturday Championships and The Trust Aoraki Aviemore Classic.

8.2 Two races will be required to be completed to constitute a series for the Championships Series.

8.3 No score will be excluded.

9.0 Alternative Penalties:

For all divisions RRS 44.1 is changed so that the 2 turn penalty is replaced by a 1 turn penalty.

10.0 Awards: [NP]

In the **CHAMPIONSHIPS** event will be awarded 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each Division.

In the **TRUST AORAKI AVIEMORE CLASSIC** will be awarded as follows;

Overall Winners; 1st on; (NZTYA Rating), (Fastest Trailer Yacht) and (Fastest Yacht)

1st, 2nd, 3rd, in each Division On; (NZTYA Rating)

NB; Results announced at prizegiving are Provisional & are subject to correction if required.

11.0 SAFETY

11.1 **LIFEJACKETS [NP]** Personal buoyancy aids as described in YNZ safety Regulation Part V, 12.1 (a) or (b) shall be worn all times. This changes RRS 40.

11.2 Competitors must comply with the requirements of the "Competitors Safety Plan"

11.3 While racing the anchor shall be securely stowed within the outside profile of the hull.

11.4 While racing, all boats must leave their centreboard in the "**fully downward**" position and in addition those with provision as provided in their class rules and YNZ Safety Regulations, must "lock" their keel in the "fully downward" position.

12.0 Disclaimer of Liability; Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to race. The Organising Authority and the Sponsors will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with, or prior to, during, or after the regatta and associated events.

IMPORTANT NOTES

1. The Trust Aoraki Aviemore Classic is not part of the Championship Series, but all boats entering the Championship Series must enter The Trust Aoraki Aviemore Classic.

2. The Prizegiving for the Champs Series and the Fun Race, will be in the Boat Harbour Marquee on Saturday Night. (COVID Level 1 only)

3. The Prizegiving for the Trust Aoraki Aviemore Classic will be held on Sunday Night, at the Boat Harbour Marquee. (COVID Level 1 only)

4. Make sure that you pick up a copy of the **Sailing Instructions** etc when you register at the Control Caravan. (COVID Level 1 only)

5. **ENSURE That Your Boat is** equipped with a **motor, as specified** in the YNZ Safety Regulations,

GENERAL INFORMATION

LAUNCHING RAMPS; At: Otematata Boat Harbour, Parsons Rock Reserve, Te Aka Creek, & Waitangi Boat Harbour.

CAMPING. Permitted in most areas. **Camp and/or Launching Ramp fees are the user's responsibility and must be paid!**

SAFETY AREAS FOR BOATS.

1. Otematata Harbour; ramp, marina, toilets and camping. (Race Control).

2. Parsons Rock Reserve; ramps, toilets, and camping. Overhead wires over small area between ramps and road.

3. Te Aka creek; new sheltered ramp.

4. Waitangi Harbour; ramp, wharf, toilets and camping.

5. Aviemore Dam – Beach on the lakes south side

6. The Gut" about 1.5km west of the dam on the lakes south side

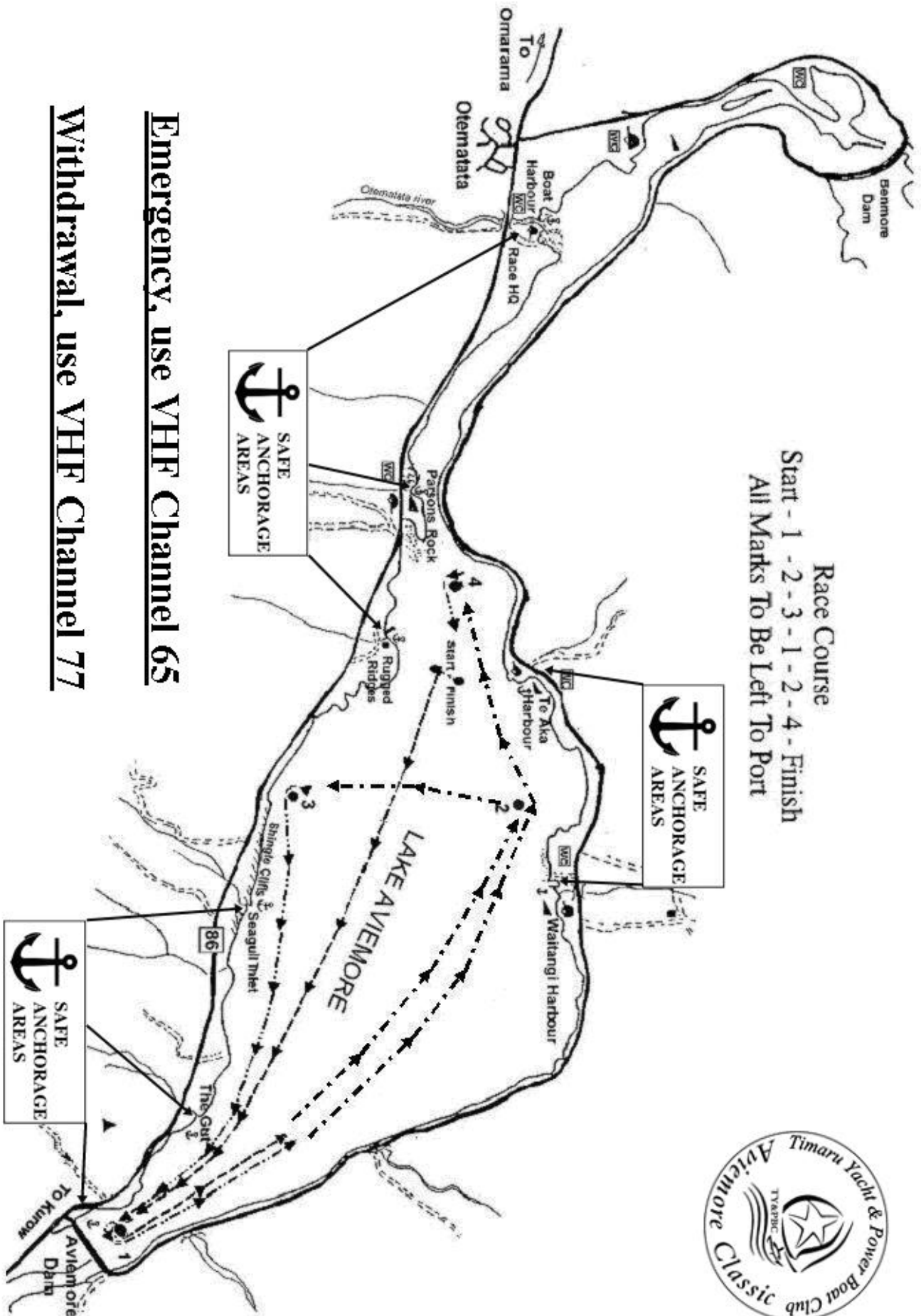

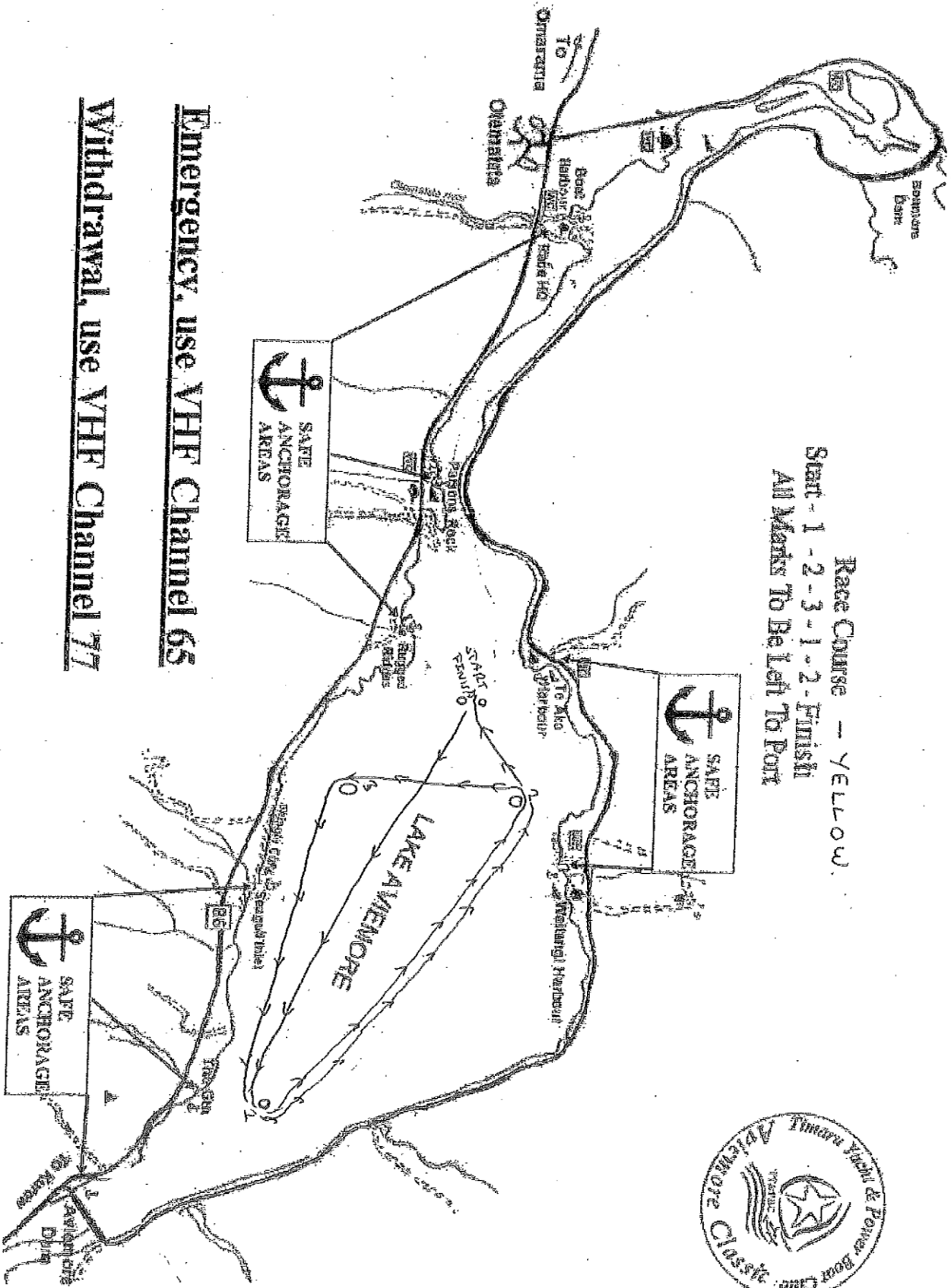
