**NOTICE OF RACE**

**1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3 The sailing instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice board located in the TYBC Club House.
- 1.4 3 starters are required to constitute a class. Classes with insufficient entries will be sailed as D Class.

**2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 2.1 The regatta is open to Optimists (green and open fleets), P-Class, Starling, Laser 4.7 & Radial, 420, O'Pen Skiff and all other youth classes.
- 2.2 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand.
- 2.3 Entrants must be under the age of 19 as of 1 January 2020 (proof of age may be required).

**3 FEES**

- 3.1 The fee for single handed classes is **\$45**; the fee for all double-handed classes i.e. 420's is **\$65**, payable at registration.

**4.4** The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 1050 hrs on Saturday and 1050 hrs on Sunday.

**4.5** On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 1500hrs.

**5 MEASUREMENT**

A boat shall comply with RRS 78.1 at 0900 hrs 15<sup>th</sup> February 2020.

**6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available after 0900 hrs 15<sup>th</sup> February 2020 at TYPBC.

**7 VENUE**

Caroline Bay & Timaru Harbour approaches.

**8 THE COURSES**

Courses will be shown as attachments to the supplementary sailing instructions provided at registration and on the notice board at TYPBC.

**9 PENALTY SYSTEM**

**9.1** RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

**9.2** RRS Appendix T1a will apply.

**10 SCORING**

**10.1** 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

**10.2** Classes will be scored together with results being based on competitor age as defined at time of entry.



**10.3**

- a) When fewer than 4 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- b) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**11 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP]

**12 PRIZES**

Certificates will be given for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each age group. Spot prizes will also be given.

**13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
